Date of the event:	Part 1: It consists of eight (8) rounds online 19 Oct – 13 Dec 2020 Part 2: It consists of eight (8) rounds online 11 Jan - 7 Mar 2021 The Final match - by March 31, 2021. The date will be specified in accordance with an actual pandemic situation development in 2021.
Venue:	The online part of the competition in shooting clubs or home shooting ranges. The Final match – in Bratislava, but the place can be changed and will be specified in accordance with an actual pandemic situation development in 2021.
Competition rules:	Rules of the ISSF and these propositions.
Type of competition:	The online league of individuals. The online qualification for the championship of the Mixed Doubles - the top 16 in each discipline.
Disciplines:	Air Pistol – 40/60, Air Rifle – 40/60
Categories:	The each discipline one mixed team only (regardless of age and gender). The one shooter may shoot both Air Pistol and Air Rifle, but the same number of shots, the shooter may not shoot two rifle disciplines, or two pistol disciplines.
Participants:	Registration closing date: no later than November 15, 2020. <u>Legal</u> <u>basis for the processing of data</u> - each competitor with his application gives the organizer consent to the processing of their personal data, including photos, publication of results and the video recording of the course of the finals and its publication.
Technical information:	<ol> <li>Electronic targets (targets of the Finnish company InBand are recommended, but not a condition) appropriate number of competition shots per 10 meters, with electronic output of the result in pdf format</li> <li>Scatt electronic simulator (condition) for any distance up to 10 meters, at a distance of less than 10 meters it is necessary to use a target reduced to the appropriate distance with electronic output of the result in pdf format</li> </ol>

	<b>3) Paper target for 10 meters,</b> for AirPistol five (5) shots to one target, for Air Rifle one shot to one target, paper targets must be evaluated using the mobile application TargetScan, with electronic output of the result in pdf format, photos of targets will not be accepted. https://targetshootingapp.com/
Time schedule:	The one (only) sent result for each round shot from Monday to Sunday and sent until next Monday until 9:00 AM is accepted. Results sent after 9:00 AM will be included in to the next round of competition. The results achieved in regular competitions or other online competitions can also be calculated as results in an online competition. The shooters who take part in the competition later, their results will not be count for competitions due to a later entry into the competition.

The Final match - until March 28, 2021 or in accordance with the actual pandemic situation development.

Weapons and ammunition, targets: Rules of the ISSF

Sending of results:(see time schedule)to the address results@strelcom.sk together with the attachedPDF file with the evaluated result. The result will not be countedfor the shooter without the attached PDF file. A file exported by anelectronic target, Scatt or Target Scan may not be further

modified. If the additional modification of the exported PDF file is demonstrated, the shooter will be excluded from the competition.

<b>Evaluation and results (processing):</b> The results will be published continuously after each		
	round. The competitors who participated in the World Championships, European Championships or World Cup in the air rifle or air pistol event happened between 2017 and 2020 will be deducted 5 points from each result to ensure the fairness of the competition. The each online part will be evaluated separately by calculating the average result from the two best and two worst results scored in each part. The overall result of the online part of the competition will be calculated as the average of the two best and two worst results scored in each part, e.g. a total of eight results in both online parts. In case of the same number of points, the total number of center tens decides, if it does not decide, the lowest calculated result decides (the one who has a higher one wins the match). The final match will only take place if a total of at least 16 competitors in each of the 4 disciplines are evaluated in the competition.	
Protests:	In the online parts of the competition within one day after the publication of the result, only an error in entering the result in the result list is accepted as a protest. In the final, protests according to the rules of ISSF with a deposit of 20 euros, which will not be returned if the protest is not accepted.	
Rewards:	The first three in each discipline in each of the online sections will receive a diploma, a medal and a prize in kind. Shooters who complete all 16 rounds will receive a certificate of completion of the first online competition in Slovakia. <u>The first mixed</u> pair wins the PARDINI air rifle and air pistol, diploma and medal. <u>The second mixed</u> pair wins the InBand electronic target at 50/10 meters and the InBand electronic target at 10 meters, diploma and medal. <u>The third mixed</u> pair wins 2 pieces of SCATT BASIC electronic trainers, a diploma and a medal. <u>The fourth mixed</u> couple wins the prize in kind, All participants in the final will receive a T-shirt and a participant's diploma.	
Finals Match:	If the pandemic situation in 2021 allows it, the finals will take place in person. The top 16 shooters in each of the four disciplines will be nominated for the finals. If one of the nominated shooters does not participate in the final, he may be replaced by a substitute who will be next in line. The key selection mechanism, which will be published after the end of the second online part (to avoid tactics in the position in the final ranking), will be mixed pairs (one air pistol and one air rifle), regardless of club, age or gender, so that one member of the	

pair will be from discipline "40" and the other from discipline "60". The mixed pairs created will fire 30 shots (each member of the pair) to decimal numbers. After firing 30 shots, the ranking will be evaluated and the 8 best mixed pairs will shoot another 20 shots (each member of the pair) to decimal numbers and the 4 best pairs will shoot the finals for gold and bronze according to ISSF rules for mixes.

It is possible to send<br/>applications to several shooters by one email, e.g. from one club.<br/>The application must state the name and surname of the shooter,<br/>year of birth, club affiliation, the discipline (can be both AirPistol<br/>and AirRifle), contact with the shooter, if will be different from<br/>sent email, the weapon and kind of the target which will be used,<br/>(electronic, SCATT or paper target evaluated using TargetScan).
